CATEGORIES OF PROPOSALS

The communication proposals submitted to the Organizing Committee, and evaluated by the Scientific Committee, may fall under the following categories: Symposia - communication proposals on a specific theme organized by the proposers, to be presented orally at a table defined by the organizing committee, with an indication of its respective coordinator. The symposium may have a minimum of 3 Communications, and a maximum of 5. Communications - communication proposals on intervention programs or research projects at an advance stage, or completed already, to present orally at a table created by the Organizing Committee.

POSTERS

Communication proposals on intervention programmes or research projects in their initial phase, ongoing or even completed, to be presented visually with a discussion. Posters shall have a maximum measurement of 1.20 cm (height) per 0.90 cm (width).

The summary of the proposals should be sent to congresso2020@aneis.org and should also meet the following requirements:

- + Size - up to 400 words.
- + Type of proposal: symposium, oral communication, or poster.
- + Structure - title, authors and affiliation/institutions, country, email contacts, keywords (up to 5).

- + Format - font Times New Roman, size 12, spacing 1.5
- + Language - must be sent both in the proposer's mother language and in English (mandatory)

Each presentation should not exceed the duration of 10 minutes, and will have 20 minutes reserved for discussion and contributions.

DATES AND REGISTRATION

- + Late Registration - after 29 February 2020
- + Submission of summaries - until 8 April 2020
- + Confirmation of acceptance - 22 April 2020
- + Submission of the full text for publication in the magazine "Giftedness" - 8 May 2020.

In order to be eligible for publishing, the text should follow APA standards and written in times new roman, size 12 with double spacing. Texts must not exceed 15 pages. Tables, figures, and bibliography (tables and figures should already be incorporated in the text and not at the end of it). Texts not structured as articles will not be published. For example, no texts resembling a list of topics or slide transcriptions will be published. Texts must be sent in word format by email to congresso2020@aneis.org.
